The days are observed from sunset to sunset. They will begin at the evening of the prior day, and continue until the evening of the listed day.

**EVERY SEVENTH DAY (SATURDAY) IS THE SABBATH DAY AND MUST BE OBSERVED.
NO WORK IS ALLOWED TO BE DONE ON THESE HOLY DAYS.**

PESACH FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD	APRIL 19, 2011
SEVENTH DAY FEAST	APRIL 25, 2011
SHAVUOT - FEAST OF HARVEST	JUNE 12, 2011
YOM TERUAH (Day of the Noise)	SEPT 30, 2011
YOM KIPPUR (Day of Atonement)	OCT 9, 2011
SUCCOTH (Feast of Tabernacles)	OCT 14, 2011
SHEMNI ATZERET (Eighth Day Solemn Assembly)	OCT 21, 2011
